AMENDMENT OF THE STATUTE OF CHARLES UNIVERSITY IN PRAGUE

The Academic Senate of Charles University,

in accordance with § 9 par. 1 point. b) and § 17 par. 1 point. a) Act No. 111/1998 Sb. on Higher Education and amendment of other Acts (the Higher Education Act), has decided on the revision of the Statute of Charles University by the following resolution:

Art. 1

The Statute of Charles University in Prague is amended as follows:

Article 36a is introduced under the existing Art. 36. The new Article including the title and the footnote reads:

"Art. 36a

Internationally recognized courses

- 1. The University conducts internationally recognized courses focused on increasing the skills of students or graduates of foreign universities^{36a} (hereinafter referred to as "internationally recognized course"). The implementation of an internationally recognized course is decided upon by the Rector following the statement of the Scientific Council. The Rector also determines the period in which the internationally recognized course can take place.
- 2. The project of the faculty or the university institute or the joint project of these components of the University regarding the implementation of an internationally recognized course is submitted to the Rector, together with the official statement of the scientific council of the faculty or university institute.
- 3. Graduates of the course receive internationally recognized university certificates and eventually are also awarded an internationally recognized degree.
- 4. The minimum requirements for the conduct and evaluation of the studies in the internationally recognized course and the details on the submission of the project to implement the internationally recognized course, their particularities and procedural details, the publishing of information regarding the internationally recognized courses, the evaluation of these courses, the admission of applicants to these courses, the fees for these courses, the issuance of internationally recognized certificates and award of degrees to graduates of these courses are determined in the Rector's provisions. The Rector's provision may also determine

which details shall be set by the provisions of the Dean of the faculty or university institute director.

- 5. The provisions issued by the Rector and eventually the Dean of the faculty or the director of the university institute pursuant to paragraph 4 as well as other information regarding the internationally recognized courses are published via the Internet. Candidates for the internationally recognized course shall be informed of them in advance.
- 6. All relations deriving from the program of the internationally recognized courses are contract-based.

Art. 2

- 2. This change of the Code comes into force on the day its registration by the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports.¹
- 3. This change of the Code takes effect five days after its entry into force.
